Summary for Recipients: TIE **Emma Kile**, senior middle hitter for Clearwater Christian College (FL) scored 100 kills this past week for 5.55 kills per set average. She also averaged 4.16 digs per set as well. On Tuesday night at home against Pasco Hernando, Kile recorded her 2,364 career kill breaking the school record held by Jenny Goodson for most kills in a career. **Torey DeLozier**, junior outside hitter for Maranatha Baptist Bible College (WI) had 72 kills (7.2 kills per set avg.) and 48 digs, 4 aces, 3 solo blocks, 5 assisted blocks and a .357 attach percentage this past week. She averaged a double-double in all three games. She helped the team secure a berth in the Northern Athletics Conference Tournament by winning all three conference games, one of which was a top-four ranked team. DeLozier surpassed the #2 all-time leader for kills in the NAC and did so in three seasons. Barring any injuries, she has a very realistic chance of breaking the all-time record sometime next season as a senior.
