**Format**

36-hole stroke play (Women)/54-hole stroke play (Men) with teams counting best of 4 of 5 scores daily

**Scorecard procedure**

Daily, each coach shall be responsible for delivering to each team member, their card prior to beginning of play. Contestants will exchange cards at their first tee and shall be responsible for signing both the card of their competitor and their own. Each player shall be responsible for their card. If desired, each coach should certify each card as correct and then insure that each card is submitted to the designated scoreboard personnel **without delay**.

**Rules for Competition**

- 1) USGA rules govern all play.
- 2) Water hazards will be marked by stakes as lateral (red) or regular (yellow). Hazard boundary will be deemed to be a parallel line along the hazard edge when viewed from stake to stake.
- 3) One ball rule is not in effect.
- 4) All men will play be from the **NCCAA Blue tee markers** and all women from the **NCCAA Gold tee markers**.
- 5) Out of bounds:
  - Defined by white stakes
  - Round rail fencing, wood fencing, web fencing when white stakes are tied to them
  - Non golf course side of water hazards: **BAD** #6, 7, 9    **UGLY** #1, #3, #5 and #9    **GOOD** #7
  - (Water line defines the out of bounds on these holes)
  - All streets are out of bounds
  - The practice range and clubhouse parking area is out of bounds
  - Note: A ball crossing a street and coming to rest on another part of the course is deemed out of bounds.**
- 5) *Mole cricket damage*: Through the green, considered loose impediment. May be removed and/or repaired on putting.
- 6) **SHUTTling**: Coaches may shuttle players (theirs or others) back to the previous spot of their last stroke when necessary. Shuttling will be allowed from #4 green to #5 tee (BAD), # 4 green to #5 tee (UGLY), and to and from clubhouse for ladies playing the Good nine.

**Drop Area (optional not required)**

Holes #7 **Bad** (across bridge to right of green) and #8 **Ugly** (right side of fairway near green)

**Tiebreaker Procedure**

Team champion tie(s) would be played off on course with all 5 players from each team competing in sudden victory format. Best 4 of 5 scores would be counted during this playoff.

Medalist tie(s) would be played off on course and would be sudden victory format.

All other team ties would be via card playoff as follows:

- Team total for 3rd round
- Team total for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> round combined
- Non counting score (3<sup>rd</sup> round), then non counting score (2<sup>nd</sup> round) and finally non-counting (1<sup>st</sup> round)

**Emergency evacuation**

In case of inclement weather, sirens will be sounded from clubhouse and strategic locations on each nine..
