Division II Volleyball

I. CHAMPIONSHIP DATE AND SITE

- A. Date – The National Championship shall be held the Thursday prior to the second weekend in November.
- B. The deadline for completion of Regional Championships is the Saturday ten days prior to the National Championship.
- C. The site requirements are as follows:
 - 1. The site shall have at least two regulation playing courts.
 - 2. The NCCAA volleyball coaches shall determine the site at the National Coaches' Meeting based on evaluation of the bid form (see Forms & Procedures Section) submitted by the specific institution.
 - 3. The Host Institution must take total responsibility for the financial and organizational aspects of the National Championship and follow the recommended NCCAA policies and procedures.
 - 4. The host institution shall take full responsibility to organize and oversee the Christian Service Project (CSP). All participating teams shall participate. The CSP shall be fully explained to qualifying teams.
- D. Bidding Procedure
 - 1. Institutions shall submit the bid form found in the Forms & Procedures Section.
 - 2. The bid shall also include any other reasons the institution should be considered. The bid shall be for a two year period and shall be sent to the National Office for review before being voted on by the coaches at the National Coaches' Meeting.
 - 3. Bids shall be submitted and voted on at the National Coaches' Meeting on odd years and shall be effective on the next odd year.

II. ELIGIBILITY

- A. Institutions must send an NCCAA affidavit of eligibility for each team to their Regional Chair, postmarked no later than the date of their first match or scrimmage.
- B. National and regional dues and statistical fees must be paid in accordance with the respective deadlines and be sent to the NCCAA National Office.

III. CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM SELECTION

- A. All NCCAA member institutions must send to the National Office a completed Declaration of Intent to Participate form by September 15 for all varsity sports. Amendments for Winter sports must be submitted by January 15 and Spring sports by March 1.
- B. If a regional winner is a dually affiliated team with conference commitments, a decision must be made by said institution by the time of the national seeding call. To give representation to the Region of the dually affiliated champion, the chair of that region may offer an at-large bid. This at-large bid shall be given the same criteria consideration as the other at-large bids.
- C. At-large berths shall be selected by the National Volleyball Committee and the National Championship Director, using the following criteria:
 - 1. The strength of the teams in question, based on season record and caliber of teams played.
 - 2. The strength of the region based on previous championship play and region number.
 - 3. If two teams are considered equally capable, consideration shall be given to the team which has not received previous at-large representation.
 - 4. Teams making a bid for an at-large berth must notify their Regional Volleyball Chair. The Regional Volleyball Chair shall make a request during the conference call and shall provide substantial information to warrant extending an at-large bid.
- D. The National Volleyball Chair shall arrange a call-in National Championship seeding conference call with the National Volleyball Committee on the Monday following the final Regional Championship as stated in Section I.B. to decide the at-large berths and the seeding of the National Championship. The call shall be made at 5:30 p.m., Eastern Standard Time (see Forms & Procedures Section).

- E. Because of the NCCAA National Office mandate/position, the DII Women’s Volleyball body shall continue to seed the National Championship with a two seeded field, if necessary. The conference call for seeding shall continue on the same calendar date. By Saturday prior to the National Championship, all participating teams shall be declared and the seeding shall be final.
- F. Seeding for the National Championship shall be as follows: The Regional Chair shall be responsible to send the following information to the National Volleyball Chair who, in turn, shall compile and pass the information along to the National Office (info@thenccaa.org) prior to the Monday conference call:
1. Regional Winner
 2. Any At-Large Bids
 3. Other information that might be helpful in seeding
- G. Criteria for seeding shall be the Modified Burbridge, along with regional and inter-regional play results. To determine the power rating, use the chart below, and then divide the sum by the number of regular season matches played. The total point values divided by the total number of matches equals the power rating.

IV. CONDUCT OF CHAMPIONSHIP

A. The championship structure shall be determined by the number of declaring regions and follow the format below, so as to guarantee at least one at-large bid:

1. Ten-team championship – two pools of five teams, with the top two teams automatically advancing to semi-final play. Quarterfinal bracket play would include 2A vs. 3B and 3A versus 2B with winners advancing to semi-final play. Overall National Championship would then create semi-final seeding with highest remaining seed opposing lowest seed and two remaining seeds opposing each other.
2. The seeding for the two pools shall be the following:

- B. Team selection and seeding shall be the responsibility of the National Volleyball Committee and shall be completed during the call-in conference call on the Monday following the final Regional Championships as stated in Section I.B.
- C. The Championship rules shall be the current NCAA Volleyball Rules.
- D. The restrictions shall be as follows:
1. The Championship shall not exceed three days.
 2. All matches shall be three out of five games.
 3. Ties in match standings at the end of pool play shall be determined by Method A (International) found in the NCAA Volleyball Rules.
- E. The official ball shall be the championship ball as determined by the contractual agreement/commitment between the preferred vendor and the National Office.

V. CHAMPIONSHIP DIRECTOR

- A. The Championship Director plans the Championship, with the approval of the National Volleyball Chair and the Director of Member Relations. A discussion of the bid contract shall take place between the National Championship Director and the National Volleyball Chair.
- B. Sends all Championship information and deadline dates to the Regional Championship Directors, Regional Volleyball Chairs and National Volleyball Chair.
- C. Invites the coaches of all Division II NCCAA participating institutions to the Coaches' Meeting and requests that agenda items be sent to the National Volleyball Chair by October 15th prior to the National Championship.
- D. Is a member of the conference call, arranged by the National Volleyball Chair and in concert with the Director of Member Relations (see Forms & Procedures Section).

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- E. Submits a completed Championship Reporting Form (see Forms & Procedure Section), in duplicate, to the National Volleyball Chair and the Director of Member Relations within **ten days** of the event.

VI. THE CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

A. Membership

1. The committee shall be composed of the National Championship Director, the National Volleyball Chair or his/her appointee(s) from the National Volleyball Committee, and the head official.
2. If a member of the Championship Committee is directly or indirectly involved in a protest submitted, this individual shall be replaced by an appointee of the National Volleyball Chair (e.g. this may be an affiliation with one of the teams involved in a protest, or misconduct of an official of a protested game).
3. Three members must be present for action to be taken.

B. Responsibilities

1. Ethical behavior
 - a. Observe the behavior of student-athletes, coaches and other team personnel during the competitive events.
 - b. Promote standards of ethical behavior during competitive events and throughout the National Championship. This can be accomplished by general reminders to individual(s) and team(s) during the National Championship, and reinforced by more specific communication. If unacceptable behavior occurs, this committee has the right and obligation to act on the issue. This may include a reprimand with official notice to the institution.
2. Protests
 - a. Assure that protest procedures as indicated in the NCAA Rule Book have been followed.
 - b. Act on all appropriate protests.

VII. NATIONAL VOLLEYBALL COMMITTEE

A. Composition and term of office

1. The National Volleyball Committee shall consist of the National Volleyball Chair (who shall chair the committee), the National Volleyball Vice-Chair and the Regional Volleyball Chairs.
2. The term of office for Regional Volleyball Chairs shall be evaluated by the regional coaches.
3. The National Volleyball Chair shall serve a three year term of office and shall be succeeded by the National Volleyball Vice-Chair.

B. Election

1. The regional coaches shall conduct an election of the Regional Volleyball Chair to the National Volleyball Committee at an appropriate time.
2. If a vacancy occurs on the National Volleyball Committee, the National Volleyball Chair shall, upon approval of the rest of the committee, appoint a replacement or conduct an election.

C. National Volleyball Committee members shall:

1. Represent the interests of the coaches and student-athletes to the National Volleyball Committee and the interests of the NCCAA to the coaches and student-athletes.
2. Solicit at-large bids for the National Championship, select at-large team(s) and seed all teams during the conference call.
3. Propose revisions of national operating policies and procedures.
4. Assist in solicitation of bids for future championship sites.
5. Submit the top eight players in the respective regions as All-American nominees.
6. Attend the Championship event to vote on All-Americans and Scholar-Athletes.

VIII. DUTIES OF THE NATIONAL VOLLEYBALL CHAIR

- A. Perform duties as listed in the Forms and Procedures Section.
- B. Communicate with the National Volleyball Committee on issues requiring its input.

IX. OFFICIALS

- A. Officials must possess at least a USA provisional rating.
- B. The selection and assignment of officials shall be made by the National Championship Director in consultation with the National Volleyball Chair.
- C. It is recommended that a minimum of six officials be used.
- D. Officials shall be required to attend all officials' meetings at the National Championship, barring extenuating circumstances.

X. MEETINGS

- A. A meeting for championship officials, with the National Championship Director and National Volleyball Chair, shall be scheduled prior to the championship.
- B. A meeting for championship coaches to discuss matters pertaining to the championship shall be scheduled prior to the opening match(es).
- C. The National Volleyball Coaches' Meeting, open to all Division II volleyball coaches, shall be scheduled prior to the championship with agenda set forth by the National Chair, including said requested items received from Division II coaches.
- D. The National Volleyball Committee Meeting, open only to the committee members or their appointees, shall be for the purpose of selecting All-Americans, Scholar-Athletes, Libero Player of Year, National Player of the Year and National Coach of Year awards (based on National Office approval of these awards).

XI. AWARDS (see Awards Section)

- A. An NCCAA Championship Team award shall be given to individual members of the Championship team.
- B. National Coach of the Year award (submitted by Athletics Director of nominating coach to respective Regional Volleyball Chair) to the coach voted by the National Volleyball Committee using the following criteria:
 - 1. Coaching Aptitude
 - 2. Christian Character
 - 3. Leadership
 - 4. Contribution to the NCCAA
- C. All-Tournament Team
 - 1. An All-Tournament Team of eight players shall be honored at the championship.
 - a. Ballots shall be distributed to coaches who may vote for eight players.
 - b. Ballots shall be collected by the Championship Director prior to the championship game.
 - c. The individuals with the highest total shall comprise the All-Tournament Team. The individual receiving the highest total shall be the Championship Most Valuable Player.
 - d. Votes shall be tabulated by the Championship Director and two worthy witnesses.
 - 2. The All-Tournament Team shall be announced prior to the championship awards.
 - 3. An NCCAA plaque shall be awarded to each selected player.
- D. Scholar-Athletes awards (see Forms & Procedures Section).

XII. EXPENSES

- A. No entry fee shall be charged.
- B. After expenses, profits shall be divided among participating institutions according to their expenses.
- C. The National Volleyball Committee requires that all gate receipts, or portions thereof, from regional championships be used to defray the cost of sending the regional champion to the National Championship.

XIII. STATISTICS

A. Statistical Reports (See [Appendix F](#))

1. The required national statistical report shall be sent to the National Statistician eight times a season. Reports must be submitted, **including report #8 required**, in order to be eligible for All-American, Scholar-Athlete, National Player of the Year and National Coach of the Year awards. Reports are considered timely and submitted if received prior to Wednesday, 12:00 p.m. (Central Time). Participating institutions will be allowed one missed report according to timeframes and requirements set above. In the event of a second missed report said institutions will be notified of the violation and become ineligible for all post-season play, including Regional Championship, and post season individual and team awards according to motions passed and set forth by the DII NCCAA National Coaches. If a report is missed, the matches played must be recorded on the next report.
2. National statistical reports shall be posted on the NCCAA website, and a National Championship Report shall be posted following the National Championship.
3. The National Championship statistical report is only for the teams participating in the National Championship and is to be sent the Wednesday following the National Committee seeding conference call. Failure to report shall result in not receiving the final statistical report from the National Statistician.
4. Statistics for eligible All-American nominations shall be submitted on the official All-American Statistical Form (see [Appendix A](#)) to the National Statistician by the Wednesday following the National Committee seeding conference call. The said report, ranking nominees in each category, shall be completed and faxed to the Regional Chairs no later than the Friday following the conference call.

B. Duties of the National Statistician

1. The National Statistician shall evaluate the accuracy of statistics submitted and, as necessary, inquire further to either correct or omit the printing of inaccurate statistics. Where possible, the statistician is expected to educate the institution in the proper recording and submitting of statistical information.
2. The National Statistician shall send the completed weekly statistical report to the National Office to be posted on the website in order to be accessed by the institutions. The report shall reflect statistics submitted by the institutions, along with any institutions not reporting for the week or reporting inaccurate statistics. According to requirements and guidelines established in Section XIII.A, those institutions not reporting shall be deemed ineligible for said awards in same section or sub-sections.

C. Scoring System

NCAA rules shall be the guideline for NCCAA Division II scoring system.

XIV. MISCELLANEOUS

All policies are in keeping with the NCCAA Division II Official Handbook.

Division II Volleyball Statistics Guidelines

ATTACK ATTEMPT is charged to a player any time the player attempts to hit the ball over the net into the opponent's court. The ball may be spiked, set, tipped or hit as an overhead contact. Any ball that is played over the net in an attempt to score a point or a side-out should be considered an attack. Any ball played over the net simply to keep the ball alive should not be considered an attack attempt.

KILL is awarded to a player any time an attack is unreturnable by the opposition or any time the attack leads directly to a blocking error by the opposition. A kill leads directly to a point.

ATTACK ERROR is charged to a player whenever an attack is: hit out of bounds; hit into the net leading to a four hit violation; blocked down by opposition to the same side as the attacker (and cannot be kept in play) and if the hitter nets, makes a center line violation, is called for an illegal contact on the antenna or hits the ball into the antenna.

ASSIST ATTEMPT is awarded whenever that player passes or sets the ball to an attacker who subsequently attacks the ball or attempts to keep it in play.

ASSIST is awarded whenever that player passes or sets the ball to a teammate who attacks the ball for a kill. A player cannot have more assists than kills.

SERVICE ACE is a serve that results directly in a point.

SERVICE ERROR is charged to a player if the serve hits the net or fails to clear the net, the serve is out of bounds or hits the antenna, the server foot-faults or takes too much time, or the player serves out of rotation.

RECEPTION ERROR is charged to a player if the serve strikes the floor in the area of the player, the player passes the serve but it cannot be kept in play by her team, or the player is called for a reception violation by the official (i.e. "lift").

DIG is awarded to a player whenever she passes a ball that has been attacked by the opposition and it is kept in play. The pass or play of any ball that is attacked is awarded a dig. The ball can be kept in play on the digger's side of the net or returned to the opposition.

BLOCK SOLO is awarded to a player whenever the player blocks the ball into the opposition's court, leading directly to a point.

BLOCK ASSIST is awarded to each player whenever two or three players block the ball into the opponent's court for a point, even if only one player actually blocks the ball.

BLOCK ERROR is charged whenever a blocker is called for netting, line violation, back row blocker or reaching over the net.
