

## The Ministry



Above, the NCCAA held a year-long food drive and collected over 6 tons of food, over \$1,700 cash. In addition, 600 lbs. clothes, 648 toys, and 906 pairs of socks were donated to pantries and shelters across the country. Student-athletes also served in nursing homes, public schools and children's homes, held free clinics, and performed many other acts of service.

Since 1968, the NCCAA has provided ministry and outreach to thousands of young men and women through intercollegiate athletic competition with a Christian perspective. Through Christian Service Projects (CSPs), athletics are used as a tool to impact the development of our young people into the leaders of tomorrow.

As America's only Christian intercollegiate athletic association, the NCCAA annually serves approximately 104 Christian colleges and universities, sponsoring 23 national championships. It also sponsors missions endeavors throughout the world, sharing the witness of Jesus Christ through athletics.
