The NCCAA Pro-Am was organized and administrated by John and Jody Wheeler from 1988-1996. The goal of the event was to raise funds for the NCCAA while serving as a retreat from the normal golf event for PGA Professionals. In 1997, an event committee was formed to carry on the effort.

In 1997, **4HIM**, the contemporary Christian music group, joined with PGA Professional, Bobby Clampett, to serve as the Honorary Hosts for the event. Bobby served through 2002 and 4HIM served until 2007. Former members of 4HIM, Mark Harris & Andy Chrisman, continue to be part of the Pro-Am.

In 2002, **Dunlop** (Dave Leverant), became the Official Award Sponsor, contributing over \$30,000 annually in product to the event. In 2009, **Mizuno** (Bill Price) replaced Dunlop and elevated the prize offerings to a new level of excellence.

In 2008, **oobe** apparel (Mike Pereyo and friends) became the Gift Package sponsor. **MailSort Inc.** (Butch Floyd) has served as the Gift Package sponsor since 2011.

Earl & Joan Wheeler have served as the lead donors to the Pro-Am (Gold and/or Platinum level) since 2004. Earl was introduced to the NCCAA via the Pro-Am by Dr. George Miller, former President at Davis College (NY).
