

Minutes from the NCCAA Central Region Meeting:

Saturday, June 4, 2011

Meeting started at 10:45 a.m.

Meeting was led by Darren Richie Athletics Director of Colorado Christian University.

With the outgoing of Dr. Jerry Boone it was stated that our region would need a new region chair. Darren said that Aimee Davison could fill this role. So for the fall of 2011, Aimee Davison the Assistant AD of Colorado Christian University will be the NCCAA Central Region Chair. All duties of the regional chair will shift from Dr. Jerry Boone to Aimee in the middle of June.

All sports chairs will stay in place through the next convention.

We discussed submitting a five year rotation of regional events. However, Crowley's Ridge felt they did not have the facilities to host a regional event. So we will stay with our four year rotation. 2011 regional tournaments are as follows:

Volleyball will be hosted by Central Christian or Oklahoma Wesleyan University - November 17 - 19.

Soccer will be hosted by SAGU(men) and DBU(women) – November 17-19.

Basketball will be hosted by Colorado Christian University – March 7-9

Baseball will be hosted by Colorado Christian University – May 3-5

Softball will be hosted by Mid America Christian University and Southwestern Christian University – May 7-9.

We now have four Schools that sponsor Tennis, so we will look at possible dates for next April to have Southwestern Christian University host> CCU, CCC, & DBU will participate.

We will need to add to the handbook that if an institution cannot host, they must give a 30 day notice unless there are special circumstances.

Host schools needs to work out a host hotel for these events. We need the cost to be below \$80.00 per night per room.
